

BIRDS OF A FEATHER FLOCK TOGETHER

MATERIALS:

- Light grey, light pink, camel and light green in Amigurumi 100% cotton (S03)
- Dark grey, red, dark blue, chocolate, ivory and Leaf green in Amigurumi 100% cotton (S04)
- Crochet hook size D3 (U.S.)/(3 mm)

WOLF

LEGS (X2):

Start with Light Grey (S03):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Light grey S03)	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	(X + V)* 6 times	18
3	(2X + V)* 6 times	24
4-5	X in each stitch	24
6	6 X + 6 Λ + 6 X	18
7	3 X + 6 Λ + 3 X	12
8	X in each stitch	12
9-11	X in each stitch (Dark grey S04) ● to join	12

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.
Fill.

TROUSER LEGS (X2):

These two pieces are worked from the last row of the body by dividing the body into two equal parts and working each one individually. First we work one, then the other, and we sew the initial gap between them (crotch).

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	18 X (Dark blue S04) ● + ○ to join	18
1-6	X in each stitch ● To join	18

Cut and fasten off. Fill.

ABBREVIATIONS:

X = Single crochet ● = Slip st ○ = Chain st

t = Half double crochet T = Double crochet * = Repeat

V = Aumento: Hacer dos pto. en un mismo pto.

Λ = Decrease: Make 1 st from 2 consecutive sts

Back loop = work the st in back of loop only

Front loop = work the st in front of loop only

- Wool sewing needle
- Safety eyes for toys or black beads
- Black sewing thread
- Filling

Start with Dark grey (S04):

Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Dark grey S04)	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	(X + V)* 6 times	18
3	(2X + V)* 6 times	24
4	(3 X + v)* 6 times	30
5	(4 X + v)* 6 times	36
6-21	X in each stitch	36
22	In Back loop: X in each stitch (Dark blue S04)	36
23	In Front loop: X in each stitch (The front loop which must be picked up is the one that can be seen after working the previous row)	36
24-31	X in each stitch	36

Fill. Do not cut yarn.

FANGS (X2):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	3 ○ (Ivory S04)	3
1	2X (starting at the second ○ from the hook) ● to join	2

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.

EARS (X2):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 4 X (Dark grey S04)	4
1	(X + V) * 2 times	6
2	(X + V) * 3 times	9
3	(2X + V) * 3 times	12
4	(3X + V) * 3 times	15
5	X in each stitch ● To join	15

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.

SNOUT (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 X (Light grey S03)	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	(3V + 3X) * 2 times	18
3-4	X in each stitch	18
5	Λ + 4X + Λ + 2X + Λ + 4X + Λ	14
6-8	X in each stitch ● To join	14

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

BOW TIE (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total Stitches
Start	11 ○ (Red S04)	11
1	9t (starting at the third ○ from the hook) Turn work	9
2	2○ to start the work + 9t ● To join	9

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.
Bind a yarn around the centre of the rectangle to form the bow.

ASSEMBLING THE PIECES:

- 1) Sew the legs inside the feet along the edges. Embroider 3 lines on each foot for the claws.
- 2) Join the arms to the body. Embroider 2 lines on each paw for the claws.
- 3) Sew the tail onto the middle of the trousers at the back of the body.
- 4) Fold the ears a little to give them form and sew them onto the head at the sides.
- 5) Join the snout to the head and embroider the nose in dark grey (S04).
- 6) Sew the fangs to the snout.
- 7) Sew the bow tie between the trousers and the snout.
- 8) Attach one safety eye to each side of the snout, and if using beads, sew them in the same manner.
- 9) Embroider the eyebrows with Light grey (S03).
- 10) Sew the base of the body of the pine tree to the trunk. When finished, sew to one of the wolf's arms.

Start with Light Grey (S03):

Start	Magic ring with 6 X (Light grey S03)	6
1	(X + V) * 3 times	9
2-4	X in each stitch	9
5-11	X in each stitch (Dark grey S04) ● To join	9

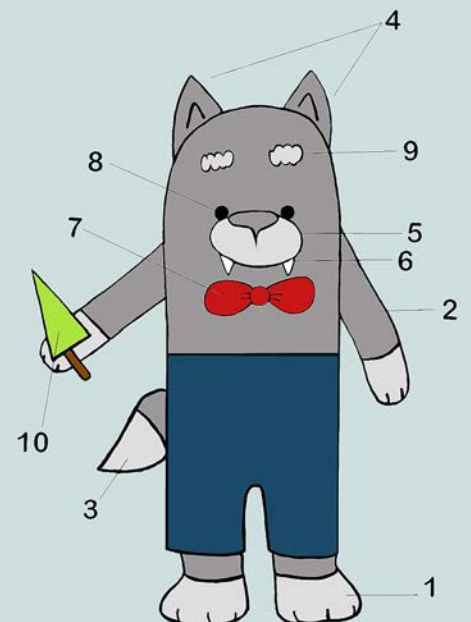

TAIL (X1):

Start with Light grey (S03):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 4 X (Light grey S03)	4
1	X + V * 2 times	6
2	(X + V) * 3 times	9
3	(2X + V) * 3 times	12
4	(3X + V) * 3 times	15
5	X in each stitch	15
6	X in each stitch (Dark grey S04)	15
7	(3X + Λ) * 3 times	12
8	X in each stitch	12
9	(2X + Λ) * 3 times	9
10-11	X in each stitch ● To join	9

HEAD-BODY (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Marfil S04)	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	X + V)* 6 times	18
3	(2X + V)* 6 times	24
4	(3 X + v)* 6 times	30
5-11	X in each stitch	30
12	(4 X + v)* 6 times	36
13	(5X + v)* 6 times	42
14	X in each stitch	42
15	(6X + v)* 6 times	48
16-20	X in each stitch	48
21	In Back loop: X in each stitch	48
22-23	X in each stitch	48
24	(6X + Λ)* 6 times	42
25	(5X + Λ)* 6 times	36
26	(4X + Λ)* 6 times	30
27	(6X + Λ)* 6 times	30
28	(3X + Λ)* 6 times	24
29	(2X + Λ)* 6 times	18

ARMS (X2):

Start with chocolate (S04):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Chocolate S04)	6
1	(X + V)* 3 times	9
2	In Back loop: X in each stitch	9
3	X in each stitch	9
4-12	X in each stitch (Camel S03) ● To join	9

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

SKIRT (X1):

This piece is worked in the front loop that is visible on row 21 of the body. What is included in () is made in the same stitch:

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	X in each front loop stitch (Red S04) ● to join	48
1	3○ to start the work + T in the first stitch 2T in each remaining stitch ● in the 3 rd ○ from the start to join	96
2	[(X + t) + 2T + (t+ X) + ●]*repeat this sequence every 4 stitches until the end of the row	196

Cut and fasten off.

LEGS (X2):

Start with chocolate (S04):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Chocolate S04)	6
1	V in each stitch	12
2	In Back loop: X in each stitch	12
3	X in each stitch	12
4-10	X in each stitch (Camel S03)	12
11	(X + V)* 6 times (Ivory S04) ● To join	18

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

TAIL (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Ivory S04)	6
1	X in each stitch ● To join	6

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

EARS (X2):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Camel S03)	6
1	2X + 2V + 2X ● To join	8

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.

SNOUT (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x (Light pink S03)	6
1	v in each stitch	12
2	(3 x + v)* 3 times	15
3-4	x in each stitch ● To join	15

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

BOW TIE (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	10 o (Dark blue S04)	10
1	8t (starting at the third o from the hook) Turn work	8
2	2 o to start the work + 8t ● To join	8

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later.

Bind a yarn around the centre of the rectangle to form the bow.

LITTLE TREE

BODY (X1):

This can be made in light green (S03) or in leaf green (S04):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 4 x	4
1	(x + v)* 2 times	6
2	x in each stitch	6
3	(x + v)* 3 times	9
4-5	x in each stitch	9
6	(2 x + v)* 3 times	12
7	x in each stitch ● To join	12

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fill.

BASE (X1):

This is made with the same color as the body:

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x	6
1	v in each stitch ● To join	12

Cut and fasten off.

ASSEMBLING THE PIECES:

- 1) Sew the legs to the body.
- 2) Sew the arms to the body.
- 3) Sew the snout onto the head and embroider a Y onto the snout in Camel (S03).
- 4) Fold the ears a little to give them form and sew them onto the head at the sides.
- 5) Attach one safety eye to each side of the snout, and if using beads, sew them in the same manner.
- 6) Embroider the fringe in Ivory (S04).
- 7) Sew the bow onto one side of the head.
- 8) Sew the light pink or red heart onto one of the sheep's hooves.
- 9) Sew the tail onto the back of the body so it is just below the skirt and centered.



LITTLE HEART:

This can be made in light pink (S03) or in red (S04).

What is included in () is made in the same stitch:

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	Magic ring with 6 x ● To join	6
1	(x + t + T + t + x) + ● + (x + t + T + t + x) + 2 x + 2 o + x ● To join	16

Cut and fasten off.

TREE TRUNK (X1):

Row	Stitches to be worked	Total stitches
Start	8 o (Chocolate S04)	8
1	7x (starting at the second o from the hook) ● To join	7

Cut yarn leaving a long length to sew with later. Fold in half and sew the sides to make the tree trunk.
