

# Cabled Jacket



## Cabled Jacket



ONE SIZE To fit bust 34/38in (86/96cm)

Width 51in/130cm (underarm at back)

20in/51cm (center back) Length

Sleeve Seam 12in/31cm

## Materials

US 10½ (7mm) needles (x2)

550 gr (about 6 skeins) Noro Obi shade #2

Measured over stocking stitch using US  $10\frac{1}{2}$  needles  $14\text{sts} \times 20\text{rs} = 4\text{in}$ (10cm) square.

#### **TENSION**

VERY IMPORTANT: Wk a tension square, if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

### ABBREVIATIONS (not all abbreviations apply to this pattern)

 $\mathbf{K} = \mathrm{knit}$ . NR = next row.foll = following.  $\mathbf{P} = \text{purl}$ .

st(s) = stitch(es).st.st. = stocking stitch (RSF knit.

rs = rows.

 $\mathbf{wk} = \mathbf{work}$ . Rev.st.st. = reverse stocking stitch

ins = inches. (RSF purl, WSF knit).  $\mathbf{dec} = \mathbf{decrease}(\mathbf{ing}).$ beg = beginning.

inc = increase(ing). alt = alternate. ch = chain. patt = pattern. dc = double crochet.

rep = repeat.tog = together.tr = treble.

RSF/WSF = right/wrong side facing. yf = yarn forward.rem = remaining. sl 1 = slip one stitch.

psso = pass slipped stitch over. cont = continue.

M1P = make one stitch purlwise thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and purl into back of loop.

MIK = make one stitch thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop.

T3F = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, purl next st from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

T3B = Slip next stitch onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then Purl stitch from cable needle.

C6F (C6B) = slip next 3sts onto a cable needle and hold at front (back) of work, knit next 3sts from left hand needle then K3sts from cable needle.

C4B = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

## Instructions

CABLE PANEL (12 sts x 8rs repeated)

Row 1: (RSF) P1, C6F, K3, P2.

Row 2: K2, P9, K1.

Row 3: P1, K9, P2.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: P1, K3, C6B, P2.

Row 6: As row 2. Row 7: As row 3.

Row 8: As row 2.

Rep these 8rs as required.

With US 10½ needles cast on 90sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs for a further 12rs.

Wk in st.st. as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2rs for a further 36rs.

Place a colored marker at each end of the last row. (indicates

Cont in st.st. for a further 38rs.

Cast off.

## Instructions (cont.)

RIGHT AND LEFT FRONT (made in one piece)

Beg at right front

With US 10½ needles cast on 55sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) P2, K9, P2, K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Row 3: P1, wk row 1 cable panel for 12sts, K2, \* P2,K2, rep from \* to and

Row 4: Rib as set 42sts, wk row 2 cable panel for 12sts, K1.

Working appropriate rs of cable panel cont in patt as set for a further 10rs

(Cable panel will be referred to as patt 12sts)

NR: (RSF) P1, patt 12sts, knit to end.

NR: P42sts, patt 12sts, K1.

Rep the last 2 rs for a further 36rs.

Place first colored marker at the beg of the last row. (indicates right armhole)

Cont in patt for a further 38rs.

Place a 2nd colored marker at the beg of the last row. (indicates right shoulder seam).

Cont in patt for a further 120rs.

Place a 3nd colored marker at the beg of the last row. (indicates left





shoulder seam).

Cont in patt for a further 38rs..

Place a 4th colored marker at the beg of the last row. (indicates left armhole)

Cont in patt for a further 38rs.

NR: (RSF) P2, patt 12sts, K2, \* P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{NR}}\xspace$  K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs for a further 10rs.

NR:P2, K9, P2, rib as set to end.

NR: Rib as set 42sts, K2, P9, K2.

Cast off.

#### *SLEEVES*

With US  $10\frac{1}{2}$  needles cast on 34sts and wk rib as given for back, inc 5sts evenly along the last row.

39sts.

Wk in st.st. as given for back AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st at each end of the 3rd row and then on every foll 4th row until 57sts. Wk straight until sleeve measures 12 ins from beg ending with a wrong side row. Cast off.

#### **MAKEUP**

Join front shoulder markers to back and then sew cast off edge of back to the  $120~\rm rs$  between markers on fronts. Sew cast off row of sleeves to back and front between armhole makers.

Sew up side and sleeve seams.



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
