Use only the yarns specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.

Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## **NEEDLES AND EXTRAS**


- 1 pair of 3.25mm (for jumper, pants and bootees) knitting needles and a set of double-pointed 3.25mm (for hat) knitting needles or the required size to give correct tension.
- 2 stitch-holders (for jumper) and 1 stitch holder (for pants).
- hat elastic (for pants).
- 2 buttons (for jumper).
- cardboard or pom pom maker for making pom poms (for hat and bootees).
- wool needle for sewing seams.



## **TENSION**

These handknits have been designed at a tension of 28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles..







# JUMPER

## BACK

Using 3.25mm needles and M, cast on 52 (64-70) sts.

Work 6 rows garter st, inc 4 sts evenly across last row ... **56** (68-**74**) sts.

7th Row: Knit.

8th Row: K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3.

Rep 7th and 8th rows 7 times.

23rd Row: Cast on one st (seam st), knit to end.24th Row: Cast on one st, purl to end ... 58 (70-76) sts.

Using **C**, work 2 rows stocking st.

Using **M**, work 2 rows stocking st.

Last 4 rows form stripe patt.

Cont in stripe patt until work measures approx **12** (14-**16**) cm from beg, ending with 2 rows **C**.

#### Shape Armholes -

Keeping stripe patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **52** (64-**70**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until **46** (56-**62**) sts rem.

Work a further **9** (11-**11**) rows stripe patt.

Using  ${\bf M}$  only for rem, cont until work measures  ${\bf 21}$  (24- ${\bf 27}$ ) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

#### Shape Shoulders -

Cast off **4** (6-**6**) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 5 sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem 28 (34-40) sts on a stitch-holder for neckband.

#### FRONT

Work as given for Back until there are **10** (12-**12**) rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a purl row. **Shape Neck** -

#### Next Row: K16 (20-20), turn.

Cont on these **16** (20-**20**) sts for left side of front neck. Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **11** (13-**13**) sts rem. **Note:** This side of neck is 4 rows lower to accommodate

shoulder opening.

#### Shape Shoulder -

Next Row: Cast off 4 (6-6) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Next Row: P2tog, purl to end.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

Slip next **14** (16-**22**) sts onto a stitch-holder and leave for neckband. With right side facing, join M to rem **16** (20-**20**) sts and knit to end.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **9** (11-**11**) sts rem. Work 3 rows.

#### Shape Shoulder -

Cast off **4** (6-**6**) sts at beg of next row. Knit 1 row.

#### Cast off rem 5 sts.

## **SLEEVES**

Using 3.25mm needles and **M**, cast on **32** (34-**36**) sts. Work 6 rows garter st, inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... **34** (36-**38**) sts.

Working in stocking st (beg with a knit row), inc one st at each end of 5th row, then in every foll alt row until there are **44** (46-**48**) sts, then in foll 4th row once ... **46** (48-**50**) sts. Purl 1 row.

Work in stripe patt as given for Back, AT SAME TIME inc one st at each end of 3rd row, then in every foll 4th row until there are **50** (56-**62**) sts.

Cont (without further inc) until work measures **11** (13-**16**) cm from beg, ending with 2 rows **C**.

## Shape Top -

Keeping stripe patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **44** (50-**56**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **38** (42-**48**) sts rem.

Purl 1 row.

Cast off  ${\bf 7}$  (8-9) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then  ${\bf 7}$  (8-10) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 10 sts.

## **NECK AND SHOULDER BAND**

Join right shoulder seam. With right side facing, using 3.25mm needles and **M**, knit up **9** (11-**11**) sts evenly along left front shoulder, knit up **5** (6-**6**) sts evenly along left side of front neck shaping, knit across sts from front stitch holder, knit up **10** (11-**11**) sts evenly along right side of front neck shaping, knit across sts from back neck stitch holder, then knit up **9** (11-**11**) sts evenly along back shoulder ... **75** (89-**101**) sts.

Knit 1 row.

**2nd Row:** K2, yfwd (to make a st), K2tog, K**3** (4-**4**), yfwd, K2tog, knit to end ... 2 buttonholes.

Work 3 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

## TO MAKE UP

Overlap front shoulder band over back shoulder band and slip stitch into position at armhole edge. Placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in sleeves evenly, noting to match stripes. Join side seams leaving garter st side splits unsewn. Sew sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

## PANTS

## BACK AND FRONT ALIKE (make 2)

#### Beg at Left Leg -

\*\* Using 3.25mm needles and **C**, cast on **32** (34-**36**) sts.

Work 6 rows garter st, inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... **34** (36-**38**) sts.

Working rem in stocking st, inc one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until there are **46** (46-**42**) sts, then in every foll 6th row until there are **48** (50-**52**) sts.

Purl 1 row. \*\*

Leave sts on a stitch-holder, break off yarn.

Rep from \*\* to \*\* for Right Leg, but do NOT break off yarn. Crotch -

Working across sts for right leg, then sts for left leg, proceed as folls:

**1st Row:** K**45** (47-**49**), K2tog, K2, sl 1, K1, psso, knit to end ... **94** (98-**102**) sts.

2nd Row: P44 (46-48), P2tog tbl, P2, P2tog, purl to end.
3rd Row: K43 (45-47), K2tog, K2, sl 1, K1, psso, knit to end.
4th Row: P42 (44-46), P2tog tbl, P2, P2tog, purl to end ...
88 (92-96) sts.

Cont to dec in this manner until 78 (84-90) sts rem.

Work 7 (10-11) rows stocking st.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until **58** (64-**70**) sts rem.

Purl one row, inc one st in centre ... **59** (65-**71**) sts. **Beg Band -**

#### Beg Bana -

**1st Row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1. **2nd Row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end. Rep last 2 rows 8 times (18 rows rib in all). Cast off **loosely** in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Join side and leg seams. Thread hat elastic through rib at waist.

# HAT

Using a set of 3.25mm double-pointed needles and M, cast on 78 (88-100) sts as evenly as possible onto 3 needles. Purl 3 rounds. Using C, knit 2 rounds. Using M, knit 2 rounds. Last 4 rounds form patt for hat. Knit 26 (30-34) rounds stripe patt. Shape Crown -1st Round: Keeping stripe patt correct, K6 (8-10), \* sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K15 (17-20), rep from \* to last 12 (14-15) sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K7 (9-10) ... 70 (80-92) sts. 2nd and Foll Alt Rounds: Knit. 3rd Round: K5 (7-9), \* sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K13 (15-18), rep from \* to last 11 (13-14) sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K6

(8-9) ... 62 (72-84) sts.
5th Round: K4 (6-8), \* sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K11 (13-16), rep from \* to last 10 (12-13) sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K5 (7-8) ... 54 (64-76) sts.

Keeping stripe patt correct, cont dec in this manner in every foll alt round until **14** (16-**20**) sts rem.

**Next Round:** \* K2tog, rep from \* to end ... **7** (8-10) sts. Knit 2 rounds.

Break off yarn, thread through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten off securely.

## TO MAKE UP

Using  ${\bf M},$  make pom pom 1.5cm diameter and attach to crown of hat.

## **BOOTEES** (beg at sole)

Using 3.25mm needles and **C**, cast on **30** (36-**42**) sts. Working in stripes of 2 rows **C** then 2 rows **M** throughout, proceed as folls:

**1st Row:** Inc in first st, K**13** (16-**19**), (inc in next st) twice, K**12** (15-**18**), inc in next st, K1 ... **34** (40-**46**) sts.

**2nd Row:** P16 (19-22), (inc in next st) twice, purl to end ... 36 (42-48) sts.

**3rd Row:** Inc in first st, K**16** (19-**22**), (inc in next st) twice, K**15** (18-**21**), inc in next st, K1 ... **40** (46-**52**) sts.

**4th Row:** P**19** (22-**25**), (inc in next st) twice, purl to end ... **42** (48-**54**) sts.

**5th Row:** K**20** (23-**26**), (inc in next st) twice, knit to end ... **44** (50-**56**) sts.

6th Row: P21 (24-27), (inc in next st) twice, purl to end ... 46 (52-58) sts.

7th Row: K22 (25-28), (inc in next st) twice, knit to end ... 48 (54-60) sts. 8th Row: P23 (26-29), (inc in next st) twice, purl to end ... 50 (56-62) sts. 9th Row: K24 (27-30), (inc in next st) twice, knit to end ... 52 (58-64) sts. 10th Row: P25 (28-31), (inc in next st) twice, purl to end ... 54 (60-66) sts. 11th Row: K26 (29-32), (inc in next st) twice, knit to end ... 56 (62-68) sts. 12th Row: P25 (28-31), (inc in next st) 5 times, purl to end ... 61 (67-73) sts. 13th Row: K25 (28-31), sl 1, K1, psso, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, K3tog, K2tog, K25 (28-31) ... 55 (61-67) sts. 14th Row: P23 (26-29), (P2tog) twice, P1, (P2tog tbl) twice, P23 (26-29) ... 51 (57-63) sts.

**15th Row:** K22 (25-28), sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, K3tog, K22 (25-28) ... 47 (53-59) sts.

16th Row: P21 (24-27), P2tog, P1, P2tog tbl, P21 (24-27) ...

**45** (51-**57**) sts. **17th Row:** K**19** (22-**25**), sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, K3tog, K**19** (22-**25**) ... **41** (47-**53**) sts.

18th Row: Purl.

**19th Row:** K17 (20-23), sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, K3tog, K17 (20-23) ... 37 (43-49) sts. **20th Row:** Purl.

**21st Row:** K15 (18-21), sl 1, K2tog, psso, K1, K3tog, K15 (18-21)

... 33 (39-45) sts.

22nd Row: Purl.

**23rd Row:** K14 (17-20), sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K14 (17-20) ... **31** (37-43) sts.

24th Row: Purl.

**25th Row:** K13 (16-19), sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K13 (16-19) ... **29** (35-41) sts.

26th Row: Purl.

**27th Row:** K**12** (15-**18**), sl 1, K1, psso, K1, K2tog, K**12** (15-**18**) ... **27** (33-**39**) sts.

Work 11 rows stripe patt (without further dec). Cast off.

## **TO MAKE UP**

Join sole and foot seams, noting to reverse seam for 2cm at top to allow top to roll over. Using M, make 2 pom poms 1.5cm diameter and attach to toes.



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
